

# PIGEON POINT DWARF COYOTE BUSH

## BACCHARIS PILULARIS 'PIGEON POINT'



THIS TOUGH AS NAILS NATIVE SHRUB IS A DWARF SELECTION THAT REACHES ONLY 1' HIGH BY AROUND 6' WIDE. THOUGH NOT PARTICULARLY SHOWY IN ITS OWN RIGHT, DWARF COYOTE BUSH PROVIDES A GENERAL GREENING OF SPACES THAT ARE TOO DIFFICULT CULTIVATE. GREAT FOR COVERING STEEP SLOPES WHERE IT PREVENTS EROSION AND SOFTENS THE LOOK OF BARE DIRT AND WEEDS. THOUGH RESISTANT TO DEER AND DROUGHT, ITS TINY CREAMY COLORED FLOWERS WILL ATTRACT POLLINATORS

RIGHT AND LEFT. ITS PLEASANT UNDULATING, LUMPY GREENNESS IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED FOR A LARGE SCALE GROUND COVER, WHERE IT CAN BE INTERSPERSED WITH WILD FLOWERS. PLANT 6-10' APART.
