LITTLE GROWN IN MODERNTIMES, QUINCE WAS ONCE KNOWN AS THE GOLDEN APPLE OF THE ANCIENTS, DEDICATED TO DETITES AND LOOKED UPON ASTHE EMBLEM OF LOVE AND HAPPINESS. THE FRAGRANT, GOLDEN FRUITWERE INVALUABLE TO EARLIER FOLKS AS A SOURCE OF PECTIN FOR PRESERVING AND AS A DELICIOUS INGREDIENT IN COOKED FRUITDISHES AND QUINCE WINE OR HARD CIDER A BEAUTIFUL SMALLTREE WITH LARGE CUP SHAPED BLOSSOMS, IT IS EASILY CULTIVATED AND REQUIRES FAR LESS EXACTING CONDITIONS FOR FRUIT PRODUCTION THAN EITHER APPLES OR PEARS, TO WHICH IT IS RELATED. WELL ADAPTED TO HOT, DRY CLIMATES, TTIS KNOWN TO NATURALIZE WELL IN THE GARDEN, AND PRODUCES ITS LARGE PERFUMED FRUTT WITHOUT A POLLENIZER TO 12-15 TALL.
