IDEAL FOR AREAS WITH HOT SUMMERS, FIGTREES ARE ADAPTABLE TO EVEN THE MOST "MEDITERRANEAN" OF CLIMATES. BROWN TURKEY REDUCES THE POTENTIAL OF WINTER DAMAGE, BEING A FULL ZONE HARDIERTHAN MOST. IT ALSO TENDS TO BE ONE OF THE LARGER GROWING VARIETTES, REACHING 20-25 TALL AND WIDE. THE AMBER FLESHED FIGS IT PRODUCES ARE DELICIOUS FRESH OR DRIED, MADE INTO JAMS, AND ARE DELICIOUS ADDED TO SALADS AND SANDWICHES. SELF FRUTTFUL, AS ARE ALL FIGS, AND NOT EVEN DEPENDENT ON POLLINATORS! NOW THAT'S PERMACULTURE! TOLERATES DROUGHT WHEN NECESSARY AND IS RESISTANT TO THE BROWSING OF DEER TO BOOT.
