PINK MUHLY, FOR MUCH OF THE GROWING SEASON IS A NICE WIRY CLUMP OF STURDY OLIVE GREEN GRASS BLADES TO 2-3 FEET WIDE. IT IS TOWARD THE END OF THE SEASON THAT IT BECOMES A TRULY BEAUTIFUL SPECIMEN. IN FALL, WHEN THE WARM PINK PANICLES OF SEED HEADS EMERGE AND THOSE SEED HEADS BECOME BACKLIT BY THE SETTING AND RISING SUN, A THING THAT SETS THE WHOLE PLANT AGLOW, THIS ONE WILL TAKE YOUR BREATH AWAY. A WARM SEASON EVERGREEN GRASS, PINK MUHLY TOLERATES MANY SOIL TYPES AND WATERING REGIMES. EASY TO GROW, IT IS BOTH DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND DEER RESISTANT. SO SUBTLE AND SO STUNNING WITH OTHER LATE BLOOMERS SUCH AS ECHINACEA AND AUTUMN SAGE.
